MacMedia Classes and Fees

Membership - \$30 – 70 annually

(see Membership benefits and fees to find which level best fits your needs)

Orientation / Producer – free with membership

(Producer class is required to submit programming for MacTV on a regular basis)

Before you begin any of the production classes offered by MacMedia, you must complete this class. You will become acquainted with the MacMedia facilities, cablecast guidelines, and options for content development.

1 hour & 30min session

Studio Production - \$30 (prerequisite class: producer)

Get up to speed quickly in the use of the MacMedia Studio. Studio production includes studio camera operation, sound mixing, character generation and technical directing. During the last session the member will get a chance to observe a show in our studio and participate as a crew member.

Three 1-2 hour sessions

Remote Camera Operation - \$30 (prerequisite class: producer)

Be prepared to create your own video content using cameras, microphones and other equipment available from MacMedia. You will learn how to operate equipment and get practice in developing your own video content for cablecast.

Two 1-2 hour sessions

Remote Multi Camera Production - \$40 (prerequisite class: producer, remote camera)

Learn the various aspects of on-location remote studio production. Topics include remote camera setup, remote video switching, audio mixing, microphones, setting up monitors and output devices and communication equipment.

Two 1-2 hour sessions

Advanced Non Linear Editing: Final Cut Pro - \$60 (prerequisite class: producer)

Editing on a more advanced level. Using Final Cut Pro, you will learn the basics of editing and have more control over your media. Topics include software settings and preferences, digital video capturing, importing files such as audio and photo, working with multiple video & audio tracks, exporting your finished program and mastering your program to DVD.

Four 2 hour sessions

*All classes teach basics and are meant for self-learners. You will need time to explore on your own to become proficient. Class length may be shorter depending on student's experience.
